Dr. Latorre is a native of St. Louis, Missouri. In 1986, he graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics from Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tennessee. Following undergraduate studies, Dr. Latorre completed graduate studies in Biology and held a teaching position at the University of Missouri-Columbia.

In 1992, he received his Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Missouri-Columbia. From 1992-1993, Dr. Latorre completed his post-graduate surgical internship at the University of Kentucky-Chandler Medical Center, Lexington, Kentucky. From 1993-1997, Dr. Latorre attended residency training in Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery at Yale University, New Haven, Connecticut. Dr. Latorre's chief resident year included resident and medical staff education. In 1996, Dr. Latorre was appointed clinical instructor at Yale University School of Medicine, Division of Otolaryngology & Cosmetic Facial Surgery.

During his residency training, Dr. Latorre's interests progressed to cosmetic and reconstructive surgery of the face. In 1997 to 1998, he completed fellowship training with the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery in California and Indiana. His training was exclusively in cosmetic surgery of the face and neck. In June 1998, Dr. Latorre successfully completed the Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery written and oral examinations held in Washington, D.C.

In May of 1999, he received his board certification from the American Board of Otolaryngology. He is a faculty instructor with the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery; authored techniques in eyelid surgery; and co-authored several instructional video presentations involving concepts in minimal invasive facial endoscopic surgery. In 1998, Dr. Latorre presented on an international level at the Seventh International Symposium sponsored by the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Orlando, Florida.

Dr. Latorre is a participant in the domestic violence program, Face to Face, established by the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. The program has gained national attention and benefited women who are victims of domestic violence.

*Latorre Plastic Surgery* was inspired by Dr. Latorre to provide all his patients a comfortable and relaxing atmosphere. Because of patient demand, he has incorporated nutritional based wellness and connects patients with personal trainers for an encompassing health & wellness program.
